WANCHESE, N.C. – Sculley Boatbuilders, a builder of custom luxury sportfishing vessels, debuted the line drawings for the new Sculley Custom 75' at the Miami International Boat Show, Feb.12 – 17. The new 75' will feature an enclosed flybridge, the first designed for a Sculley Sportfisherman. The new vessel will feature the Sculley “Modern Look” and have a mezzanine in the cockpit, and a cockpit ventilation system.

“The new 75' was originally planned as a 74', but the client needed the extra foot to allow for some design changes in the interior layout. This is a perfect example of the level of customization and detail that Sculley provides its customers.” Says Jimmy Sculley, Marketing Director for the company. “This is why clients come to us, they know that they are going to get exactly what they want with no compromises or shortcuts.”

The new enclosed flybridge generated a lot of interest in the Sculley booth at the new Big Game Room at the Miami International Boat Show. Most viewers commented that the new enclosed flybridge was the “sleekest one they have ever seen”. The booth also featured line drawings of the new Sculley 50 Express and the new 64 Custom. The artwork of Be Forbes, who's contribution to the Sculley 60' “Waterproof” helped secure its sale, was also prominently displayed. The booth, nicknamed “The Sculley Lounge” also included a large screen TV that displayed footage from the Sculley promotional video, the “Waterproof” fishing in the recent Buccaneer Sailfish Cup Tournament where the vessel placed 3<sup>rd</sup> overall, and footage from the Be Forbes promotional DVD showing the artist swim with, photograph, then paint the piece that was ultimately re-created in glass for the salon of the “Waterproof”.
