WANCHESE, N.C. – Sculley Boatbuilders, a builder of custom luxury sportfishing yachts, is proud to announce their entry into ESPN2's Billfish Extreme Release League (BXRL). This move came at the recent Miami International Boat Show, and the first tournament Sculley will participate in will be in Key Largo, March 1st – 4th.

“The move came rather suddenly when (longtime friend) Sam Peters (of Release Marine) came to me and my father during the Show and told us there was an opening in the BXRL.” Said Jimmy Sculley, Marketing Director for the company. “Me and my father (Jim Sculley Sr.) were very interested, so we approached Tim (Tim Graboski, the owner of the “Waterproof”) with the Idea and he said OK.” Thus Sculley entered the BXRL with Release Marine as a sponsor. Later Sculley added Maui Jim Sunglasses as a sponsor as well.

“Fishing the Buccaneer Cup Sailfish Tournament together on the “Waterproof” is what brought this team together” says Jimmy Sculley “getting top boat the first day we ever fished together and coming in 3rd in the tournament gave us confidence in each other and the boat.” The lineup for the Sculley team will be basically the same as it was for the Buccaneer Tournament with Capt. Mario Fortier at the helm, with the Sculley's, both father and son, taking turns at the helm and at fishing, and of course, owner Tim Graboski will be fishing the vessel with mates Casey Hunt and Jeff Sharp rounding out the team.

The Sculley's plan on replacing the “Waterproof” with a new “Modern Look” Custom Sculley 60' in June for the Antigua Tournament and all future Tournaments in the series, and are very excited about the BXRL and their participation in the series. In an excerpt from the BXRL sign up documents Sculley writes.

“Only through the televised coverage of events will the “average Joe” be able to experience this sport without the high costs of travel and boat charters/ownership. It is our hope that this will lead to the same kind of increased interest that NASCAR experienced when it received the appropriate

coverage. These types of sports are generally so cost-prohibitive for the public at large that only through this enhanced TV coverage do the public get to experience how fun and exciting the sport really is."
